**Note:** Entries judged in previous Heritage Quilt Guild of Van Zandt County or Texas Star Quilters Guild shows will not be accepted. Entries will only be accepted from Van Zandt and adjoining counties (Rains, Smith, Henderson, Kaufman, Hunt, and Wood) or from members of the Guild.

## GENERAL RULES:

- **The owner/exhibitor MUST have made the top of the quilt in order to qualify for entry in this show. Quilts or tops which have been awarded from a raffle, gifted, or purchased cannot be submitted as an entry; but may be displayed as an Exhibit Only.**
- No double knit items will be accepted.
- If you have a **label** on the back side of the quilt that states the name of the quilt and quilt maker(s), it must be covered.
- All entries should be clean, pressed, ready for display, and have a **sleeve**.
- Quilts entered for judging should have had the last stitch completed since last year's quilt show. Example would be a "UFO" that was begun years ago, but finally completed this past year.
- TSQG Quilt Show Committee has the final decision on quilt category and has the right to place a quilt in a more applicable category.
- Quilts listed for sale: prices will not be listed on the quilt for public display. Prospective buyers will be directed to the TSQG booth, where the volunteers will have access to the price you have set. They will not negotiate for a lesser amount. If you are present at the Show, an attempt to contact you will be made so that you may negotiate with the buyer in person.

## QUILT CONSTRUCTION:

- **1 PERSON QUILT** is a quilt that only one person created from piecing blocks, through quilting and binding.
- **GROUP QUILT** is a quilt that more than one person worked on. This may include someone other than the entrant making a block(s), adding borders, doing the quilting and/or attaching the binding.

## QUILTING THE QUILT TOP:

- **DOMESTIC MACHINE QUILTING** is any quilt done on a sewing machine, where the quilting is done by moving the fabric sandwich under the needle.
- **MID OR LONGARM QUILTING** is any quilt done on a machine designed for quilting, where the quilting is done by the machine moving over the fabric sandwich.
- **COMPUTERIZED QUILTING** is any quilting designs aided by a computer design. This includes computerized longarm quilting or embroidery machine quilting designs, etc. If any portion of the quilting is computer aided, it will be considered computerized.

## GENERAL TERMS:

- **ART QUILT** = An original design. A quilt that deviates from the use of traditional, historical blocks & patterns. Emphasis is on the design rather than functionality. Includes but not limited to Landscape Quilts, Collage Quilts, Pictorial or Portrait Quilts.
- **KIT QUILT** = A quilt made from a pre-packaged pattern and specially selected fabrics needed to make a specific quilt. May include fabric yardage or pre-cut fabrics.
- **MIXED TECHNIQUE** = a balance of piecing and appliqué
- **PANEL QUILT** = The use of an entire fabric panel as the focal point. May be made up entirely of just the panel or a quilt pattern that uses the panel for part of the design.
- **WHOLE CLOTH QUILT** = Made of one solid piece of fabric, typically white or off-white, made to showcase the maker's needlework skills.
- **ALL OTHER TECHNIQUES** = (open category)—Quilts that do not fit into the pieced, appliqued categories above--includes crazy quilts, cathedral windows, hand embroidered, whole cloth, rag and yo-yo quilts.
