Entry forms, with a picture attached must be received no later than August 18th, 2025, mailed entry forms must be post-marked no later than September 1st, 2025.

Please submit forms at a guild meeting or postmarked by Deadline and mailed to Texas Star Quilters Guild, PO Box 1084, Canton, TX 75103. If you are not a member of the Texas Star Quilters Guild, there will be a \$25.00 entry fee. **If you are mailing your quilt, you must have prepaid return postage and insurance included.**

Note: Entries judged in a previous Texas Star Quilters Guild show will not be allowed for judging but may be entered for exhibition. You cannot enter a quilt unless you are **the person who pieced it**

Check in 9:00 AM – 12:00 PM, Wednesday November 5th, 2025. All quilts must have a sleeve for hanging, be in a pillowcase with name and phone number permanently attached. Quilts must be folded so the sleeve is at the opening of the pillowcase. Only one quilt per pillowcase.

The Guild reserves the right to make the final decision as to what category the quilt is entered in.

Categories

(100) SMALL QUILTS: Pieced, measuring (all four sides) 210" or less. This includes lap, wall and baby quilts.

(200) MEDIUM QUILTS: Pieced, measuring (all four sides) 211"-299" total.

(300) LARGE QUILTS: Pieced measuring (all four sides) 300" or larger.

(400) MIXED TECHNIQUES: Any size, A **balance** of two or more techniques.

(500) MINIATURES: These are a reduced or miniaturization of a traditional size quilt. If blocks are used, they can be no larger than 4". The quilt must measure 24" or less per side.

(600) HAND WORK: Any size quilts that are constructed by hand. Any size hand applique or hand embroidery quilt can be pieced and quilted by machine or by hand.

(700) MACHINE APPLIQUE and/or Embroidery: Any size.

(800) MISC: Panel quilts, t-shirt quilts, any size.

(900) ART QUILT: **Must be your original design!!** Kits, commercial patterns, designs from books and magazines are **NOT** eligible for this category.

(Spec) SPECIALTY: Any size, such as yo-yo's, cathedral window, painted, photo transfer embellished, whole cloth, etc: Any technique that does not fit into other categories.

(New) 1ST QUILT TO BE ENTERED IN A SHOW: This must be the first quilt you have ever entered in any show and you **cannot** enter any other quilts in your first show.

(17) YOUTH: 17 and under. Any technique, quilting can be done by entrant or another person.

(Other) HOME DÉCOR, WEARABLES, 3-D, ETC : Items for the home such as placemats, table runners, tablecloths, pillows, Jackets, vests, aprons, stuffies, pin cushions, purses, items not related to any of above categories.

(E) EXHIBITION ONLY: These quilts will not be judged.

- Entries mailed in and not being picked up in person must include prepaid return postage and insurance
- All Entries must include a color photograph with the entry form.
- Labels must be covered.
- Sleeves are mandatory, quilts will not be accepted without a sleeve.
- Quilts are to be inside a pillowcase, folded so the sleeve is at the opening of the pillowcase and must have entrants name and phone number permanently attached.
- You must have your receipt for pick up! **No exceptions!**

Note: The Guild reserves the right to make the final decision as to what category the quilt is entered in.
